In the mid-1500s, the unicorn was introduced to the royal coat of arms of Scotland, representing the natural enemy of England's national animal, the lion.

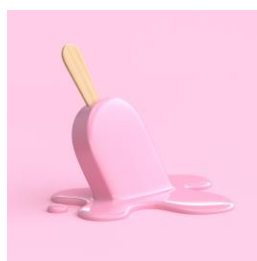


Fun Fact!!!
