#### Illegal Substances seized at Mountain Institution in Agassiz

On November 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Institution staff seized cannabis and meth valued at a stacking \$139,000. Over a course of 2 days the Mountain Institution staff seized 184 grams (about 6.49 oz) of Cannabis and 94 grams of Methamphetamine. Correction Service Canada (CSC) is currently investigating on how the substances entered the Institution.
